



The Aspire Artemis Foundation (AAF) is an organization that is thoroughly committed to improving the lives of girls and women from vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds through innovative early interventions, education, information sharing, research, and training, by working to create an inclusive environment for women and youth. The activities of the Foundation strive to bridge the gaps between theory, policy, and practice.

Additionally through our programming, we seek to inspire today's youth by highlighting the achievements of brave and brilliant women who, despite adversity, have aspired to surpass expectations to make a change in people's lives and to leave a footprint which echoes globally so that young people can see what they can be.

Our intention is to contribute to long-term development, sustainably change lives, foster strong communities, engage neighboring cultures, and make a positive impact.











Our Unique Approach

There exists a gap between the number of women pursuing and remaining in STEM based careers. At the Aspire Artemis Foundation, we address this gap issues by using a unique three-pronged approach called EMI (or "Emmie"). We believe that supplementary education, coupled with organized in-person mentorship, and internship experiences, helps and supports young women as they shape their own paths for a STEM-centered future.

The Foundation implements this approach through a variety of avenues.











Current challenges

It is estimated that currently half of the population of the world lives on 2 dollars a day.

Some people have jobs that do not allow them to live their lives in dignity.

Disadvantaged groups do not have access to sufficient training opportunities that prepare them for the jobs that exist

Access to funding and job opportunities in the engineering field for women are not equal to that of men.

The current education system is not designed to include women in typical STEM based programming.





- Women are important drivers of innovation and change and can create opportunities for self-sustenance as well as contribute positively to ensuring sustainable life-changing goals.


Investing in women


